Dear members of the assembly of the Asian Forest Cooperation Organization, observers and partners, year 2021 is a challenging time as we celebrate our third founding anniversary.

Covid 19 pandemic has affected our activities at the regional and at the country level. But this should not in any way discourage us in achieving our planned activities and regional commitments. I especially thank our member countries for making extra effort to complement the potential gaps in the implementation and monitoring of project activities through virtual and in-person site visits including more frequent consultation with the secretariat.

It is of great pleasure to report to you that we had successfully secured commitment from our major donor, the Korea forest service an amount of \$4.1 million for our 2022 projects subject to the approval of the assembly this coming October 2021. We have also requested for a December 2021 donors meeting in order to facilitate project implementation for the following year.

We have participated in major global discussion on forests; the International Day of the Forest Celebration of the Food and Agriculture Organization and the United Nations Forum on Forests. We will actively participate in the 16th session of the United Nations Forum on Forests this April 26-30 2021 including our side event on April 29th entitled "Progress of AFoCO Member Countries on the United Nations Strategic Plan on Forests Implementation and its Contribution to the Attainment of the Global Forests Goals, in Partnership with National Institute of Forest Science of the Korea Forest Service".

We will participate in the upcoming P4G Summit in Seoul on May 30-31 2021, (partnering for global green growth 2030) a multilateral summit on the environment hosted by the Republic of Korea that aims to unite heads of states, CEOs of the private sector and civil society leaders to be a major acceleration moment for P4G. Our side event entitled "Forest-Based Solution-a Path to Building Back Better " will be participated by international partners, private sector and NGOs. In this event we will be launching our landscape partnership Asia for Asian drylands and drought prone areas as we expand our partnership and fund mobilization.

We will continue to invest in capacity building program as planned but will have to make some virtual arrangements due to Covid 19 and the limitations in our regional education and training center. Despite this situation we were able to successfully conclude the training program on project development attended by 46 participants from member parties. We have another one on climate change slated for this May 2021.

Despite the challenge brought to us by the Covid 19 pandemic, we should take this year 2021 as an opportune time for AFoCO and member parties to reflect , as we focus our goal in the upcoming global declaration and events; the 2020-2030 UN Declaration of Ecosystem Restoration , 2020-2030 Global Biodiversity Framework in Kunming, China this November 2021, and the 2021 United Nations Climate Change Conference also known as COP26 in Glasgow UK on November 1-12, 2021 , as well as the submission of the nationally determined contribution 2020-2030.

As a formal regional body, we, at the AFoCO secretariat and its member parties will stay committed to provide the bridge in order to enhance cross sectoral cooperation and broaden coordination among member parties and our partner institutions on the management of forests for the sustainable production of economic goods and ecosystems services, biodiversity conservation and climate change mitigation and adaptation.

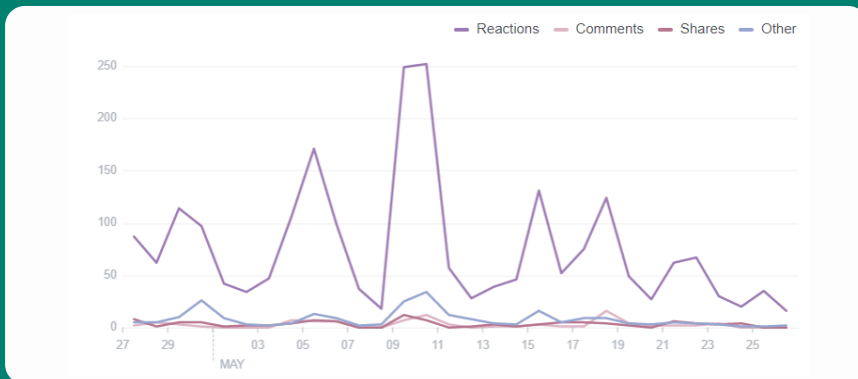

Saxaul is an evergreen shrub-like species native to the deserts of Central Asia. The powerful root system of a Saxaul, especially black, draws groundwater from deep beneath the ground. As a highly drought-resistant species, it has the potential to counter desertification and help restore drylands.

In October 2020, AFoCO joined hands with A.N. Bukeikhan Kazakh Research Institute of Forestry and Agroforestry (A.N. Bukeikhan KazRIFA) to implement its first project in Kazakhstan. The 2-year project on the "Investigation of the resistance of black saxaul (*Haloxylon aphyllum*) forms to gall-forming insects" will study the resistance of specified black saxaul plants among species damaged by gall-forming insects. Research will be conducted to identify resistant plants and study their anatomical and morphological features, biochemical properties, and genetic structures. Plans to organize seminars with the staff of regional forest institutions are also underway.

The research project is funded by the National Institute of Forest Science (NIFoS) of the Republic of Korea, as a part of the #AFoCO-NIFoS collaboration.
